Application of American Trans Air, Inc. filed 1/7/98 in Docket OST-95-963 for:

**Remarks:** American Trans Air requested a waiver from the 60-day advance filing requirements of 14 CFR 377 to ensure that its authority would continue in effect beyond the expiration date (January 18, 1998), pending action on its renewal application. On January 9, 1998, we orally granted the request. We confirm that action here. American Trans Air's authority, therefore, has remained in effect pending action on its renewal application.

We acted on this application without awaiting expiration of the 15-day answer period with the consent of all parties served.
