**Docket OST-99-6410, Complaint of the American  
Society of Travel Agents, Inc., and Joseph Galloway**

On October 26, 1999, the American Society of Travel Agents and Joseph L. Galloway (collectively, "ASTA") filed a complaint against sixteen air carriers in Docket OST-99-6410. On or about December 10, the respondents filed answers to the complaint. On January 20, 2000, ASTA filed a motion for leave to reply to the answers; on January 24, it filed a motion for leave to amend its complaint. On March 27, ASTA filed a motion for leave to amend its complaint a second time.

We will grant all three of ASTA's motions. No party has opposed any of them, and one party, Delta Air Lines, has already filed an answer to ASTA's second requested amendment (along with a motion for leave to answer, which we will also grant). Because the second amendment adds allegations to ASTA's original complaint, we will treat it as a complaint and allow the other parties fifteen days to answer it, making answers due on April 27, 2000.

We will serve this Notice on all parties.
