ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On March 10, 2000, Airline Partner Associates, Inc. d/b/a TransPacific Airlines filed an application in Docket OST-2000-7069 requesting a certificate authorizing it to provide interstate scheduled air transportation of persons, property, and mail. By letter dated June 6, 2000, the applicant withdrew its application pending completion of financing arrangements for its proposed operations. We will grant Trans Pacific's request and dismiss its application without prejudice to its filing a new application in the future should it choose to do so.

ACCORDINGLY, Acting under authority assigned by the Department in its Regulations, 14 CFR 385.12:

1. We dismiss, without prejudice, the application filed on March 10, 2000, by Airline Partner Associates, Inc. d/b/a TransPacific Airlines in Docket OST-2000-7069, requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
2. We will serve a copy of this order on the persons listed in Attachment A.

Persons entitled to petition the Department for review of this order, under 14 CFR 385.30, may file their petitions within 10 days of the service date of this order.

This order shall become the final action of the Department of Transportation upon expiration of the above period unless within such period a petition for review is filed or the Department gives notice that it will review this order on its own motion.
