NOTICE OF REGISTRATION OF TRADE NAME

On September 14, 2000, Miami Air International, Inc.¹ requested that the Department register the trade names "Quest Cargo International" and "QCI" for use in its air transportation operations.

Part 215 of the Department's regulations (14 CFR Part 215) provides that any carrier wishing to use an alternative trade name must first register that name with the Department. The rule further states that the Department may register a trade name after the carrier gives notification to similarly named carriers of the proposed use of the name. In this case, there are no similarly named carriers; hence, no notification was required.

Under these circumstances, we register "Quest Cargo International" and "QCI" as trade names to be used by Miami Air International in its operations.
