**FINAL ORDER**

By Order 2000-9-20, served September 20, 2000 we directed all interested persons to show cause why we should not make final our tentative findings and conclusions that TIE Aviation, Inc. d/b/a Trans International Express has failed to demonstrate an operating proposal that could be determined reasonable and that it should be denied the section 41102 certificate and *pendente lite* exemption authority it sought. Interested persons were given 14 days to file objections to the order.

No objections to the show-cause order were received.

**ACCORDINGLY:**

1. We find that TIE Aviation, Inc. d/b/a Trans International Express has failed to demonstrate a reasonable operating proposal, and we deny the applications filed in Docket OST-00-7168 for authority to conduct foreign charter all-cargo air transportation and in Docket OST-00-7197 for a *pendente lite* exemption pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 40109.

2. Unless disapproved by the President of the United States under 49 U.S.C. 41307, this order shall become effective on the 61<sup>st</sup> day after its submission for section 41307 review or upon the date of receipt of advice from the President or his designee under Executive Order 12597 and implementing regulations that he or she does not intend to disapprove the Department's order under that section, whichever occurs earlier.<sup>1</sup>
