**ORDER REVOKING FOREIGN CERTIFICATE**

By Order 2001-5-25 , issued May 21, 2001 , we revoked for reasons of dormancy the certificate issued to Sun Pacific International, Inc., by Order 97-12-4 authorizing it to engage in interstate charter air transportation.

By this order, we are revoking a companion certificate issued by Order 97-12-4 authorizing foreign charter air transportation. Instead of repeating our findings and conclusions in Order 2001-5-25 we incorporate them here by reference.

**ACCORDINGLY**, acting under authority assigned by the Department in its Regulations 14 CFR 385.12:

1. We revoke the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Sun Pacific International, Inc., by Order 97-12-4, authorizing it to engage in foreign charter air transportation.
2. Unless disapproved by the President of the United States under section 41307 of Title 49 of the United States Code, this order shall become effective on the 61st day after its submission for section 41307 review or upon the date of receipt of advice from the President or his designee under Executive Order 12595 and implementing regulations that he or she does not intend to disapprove the Department's order under that section, whichever occurs earlier.<sup>5</sup>
3. We will serve a copy of this order on the persons listed in Attachment A.

The action taken in this order shall be effective immediately, and the filing of a petition for review shall not alter its effectiveness.
