Dear Mr. Slabowski:

This responds to your letter regarding change of the identification number for materials described as "Dangerous Goods in Machinery" or "Dangerous Goods in Apparatus" in a Final Rule issued under Docket HM-215D (66 FR 33316; 6/21/01).

You asked what the appropriate "Guide Page" is from the 2000 Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) applicable to materials described as "Dangerous Goods in Machinery" or "Dangerous Goods in Apparatus", since the identification number for the above description was changed from "NA 8001" to "UN 3363" in Docket HM-215D.

The final rule issued under Docket HM-215D aligned the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR; 49 CFR Parts 171-180) with the international standards by incorporating various changes to proper shipping names, in addition to other changes. The effective date of this rule was October 1, 2001 and compliance with the amendments adopted in this final rule is required beginning October 1, 2002.

In the 2000 ERG, emergency response information is designed to be identified through looking up a proper shipping name or an identification number. Although the ERG has not as yet been updated to include the identification number "UN 3363", the appropriate guide page number applicable to the shipping name "Dangerous Goods in Machinery" or "Dangerous Goods in Apparatus" is "Guide 171", as determined by consulting the "blue" pages of the ERG, which contains the proper shipping names. The next edition of the ERG will be updated to list UN 3363, and any other new identification numbers or shipping names.

I hope this satisfies your inquiry.


On the 21-June-2001, the subject document was published in the Federal Register. By virtue of this fact, sections of 49 CFR Part 171, et al have been revised. Because of this action, I have the following question.

With regards to: Dangerous Goods in Machinery or Dangerous Goods in Apparatus (UN3363) as listed on page 33360 of the referenced Federal Register,

Question: Using the 2000 Emergency Response Guidebook - No. ERG2000, please advise what Guide Number is applicable to this item?

The reason for my request, is that Dangerous Goods in Machinery or Dangerous Goods in Apparatus (UN3363) is not listed in the 2000 Emergency Response Guidebook - No. ERG2000. However, Dangerous Goods in Machinery or Dangerous Goods in Apparatus (NA8001) is listed and Guide No. 171 is applicable to this item. It appears that the Identification Number for Dangerous Goods in Machinery or Dangerous Goods in Apparatus was changed by virtue of the subject document.
